




It's that time of year again, for Antenna's

COLLECTORS CORNER By Tim Soxman W3ZVT

One of the Vibroplex keys that are not seen too often is the Vibroplex Zephyr. The reason that it is not seen too often was a matter of economics and its unfortunate positioning in the key lineup of Vibroplex keys. The Zephyr was positioned between the Original and the Champion as far as prices went and had a circuit closer and a three-inch wide base. It was manufactured between 1939 and 1958 and only came in black base models. The early Zephyrs had black japanned bases and are more rare than the black crackle finish ones.

Because of the Zephyrs position in the Vibroplex lineup, folks that wanted a cheaper key bought the Champion and the guys that could afford a better key bought the Original. As a result the Zephyr was seen as not much better than the Champion and not as good as the Original. This caused the Zephyr to be pretty thin on the ground as far as used keys go. Tom French's Vibroplex Collectors Guide lists the Zephyr as "uncommon".






BAD WEATHER PRECAUTIONS

YEAR 2001 W3PIE PICNIC




